- ✓ Refine fundamental movements such as; rolling, crawling, walking, running etc.

- ✓ Begin to explore moving body with coordination
- ✓ Begin to develop fine motor control when using a pencil or scissors
- ✓ Develop good posture when sitting
- ✓ Further develop skills to manage in school; lining up and meal times

Literacy

- ✓ Start Level 1 / 1+ phonics listening to the sounds that we can here around us
- ✓ Begin to blend words orally through games; such as "put your hand on your l i p"
- ✓ Begin to make meaningful marks using a pencil / Write our first names

Understanding the World

- ✓ Talk about members of their family
- ✓ Compare / contrast with stories from the past
