<u>Farewell</u>: This week we are saying "Goodbye" to Miss Fitzsimmons. She has been a great support to both children as well as in running our Before and After School Club. We wish her well in her future endeavours.

Before and After School Club: With Miss Fitzsimmon's departure we obviously have a vacancy to recruit for her replacement. At present, we have not had any response to the job advert, but have a temporary staffing arrangement that will allow us to keep providing wrap-around childcare as we are currently – thank you to Miss Horsey and Mrs Pargeter who will be supporting Miss Seward at both Before and After School Clubs – and they should be able to do this until half term. If the situation changes, especially if it affects what we can provide, I will let you know as soon as possible. <u>Marathon Runners</u>: On Sunday 3<sup>rd</sup> October, two of our members of staff will be running the London Marathon. <u>Census Day Menu: Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> October</u>: Please see attached Census Day Menu. Census data is collected from schools to determine future funding. Part of this is the number of school dinners eaten!! If your child is in KS1 or in receipt of Free School Meals, it will be really beneficial to school (ie it will generate extra funding) if your child could have a school dinner on this day. The Census Day Menu Choices are:

The deadline for secondary applications this year is <u>Sunday 31<sup>st</sup> October 2021</u> This is extremely important as any applications received after this date will not be considered until after 1<sup>st</sup> March 2022. Most secondary schools are now advertising their Open days, please check secondary school's websites, for details of these. If your child will be attending an Open day, please ensure you complete a leave of absence form for their absence to attend.
